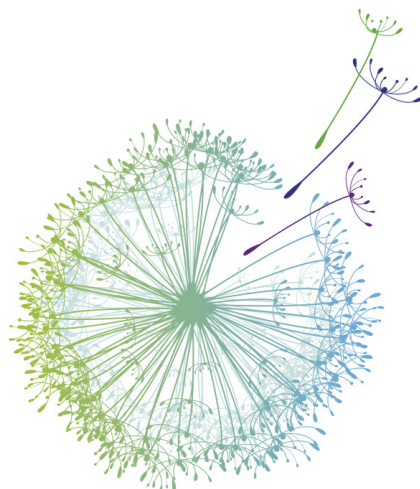

REGULATIONS

In order to take part in this competition, the rules must be obeyed.

First. Participants.

The competition is open to all people within the age groups stated, whether or not they go to the El Pinar school.

Second. Subject Matter.

The spirit of the competition is to highlight photographically any aspect of the values of the natural world. No photographs will be published which contain material which cross the boundaries of good taste or which violate rules of personal or family intimacy or images of people. In short, no file will be accepted which contravenes current legislation.

Third. The photograph.

The photographs may not be edited or enhanced electronically or by any other means. In addition, photomontages will not be accepted. Minimal correction of colour or luminosity will be permitted. Photographs which have previously won prizes will not be accepted. Participants should state that it is their own work, and are responsible for the consequences and damages which could be derived from copyright infringement. The copyrights of the winning photographs will be retained by the photographers.

Fourth. Participation.

How to take part

The photographs should be taken with a digital camera (files obtained by scanning analog photographs are not permitted). Photographs must be presented as RAW, TIFF or high quality JPG (no compression) formats. There is no size (Mb) limit, with no interpolation. All photographs should follow these rules and participants who do not conform to the rules will be automatically disqualified.

Categories

Juvenile, 7 to 18 years of age.

Adult, over 18s.

General. Prize winning photographs will faithfully capture the essence of the natural world with the greatest artistry.

International Year for Sustainable Tourism for Development. Prize winning photographs will reflect any topic related to this celebration (more info about the IYSTD can be found in <http://www2.unwto.org/tourism4development2017>).

Facebook popularity. Those photographs which receive the greatest number of “likes” on Facebook will also receive prizes. The centre will choose a selection of photographs which will be displayed on Facebook to be voted on.

Identification and forwarding

In order to take part in the competition, you should send an email to fotografia@colegioelpinar.com containing the details of the participant and attaching the photographs to be entered. The following information should be included:

- Name and surnames of the competitor
- NIF or NIE
- Contact email
- Contact telephone number
- Make and model of the camera used
- Image Title
- Place and date
- Category: JUVENILE or ADULT; GENERAL or INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF SUSTAINABLE TOURISM FOR DEVELOPMENT (IYSTD)

Reproduction of the images

The finalists and winners may have their photographs reproduced in catalogues, on posters or whatever promotional support is deemed necessary crediting the photographer. The centre may use all of the work presented with the sole purpose of disseminating the competition. Once the photographs have been sent each one will be analysed prior to exhibiting them in the online gallery. The participant will accept that their photograph will be exhibited on the school's official website and on the social media channels of the competition (Facebook, Twitter, Google+ , Tumblr and Flickr.) The school will not use these photographs for any commercial ends, nor for any other purposes other than those aforementioned.

Closing Date

Submissions will be accepted until 21st February 2016.

Fifth. Judges Decision.

The decision of the Judges will be made on March 17th 2016. If, in the Judges Opinion there are no submission of sufficient quality, the prizes will not be awarded. The evaluation criteria will be based on the creativity and quality of the photographs. The selection of the winners will be at the Judges discretion and their decision will be final and absolute.

Sixth. Prizes.

Five prizes and the corresponding diploma will be awarded, in the following categories:

Juvenile, 7 to 18 years of age.

- **General:** Experiment Set
- **IYSTD:** Experiment Set

Adult, over 18s

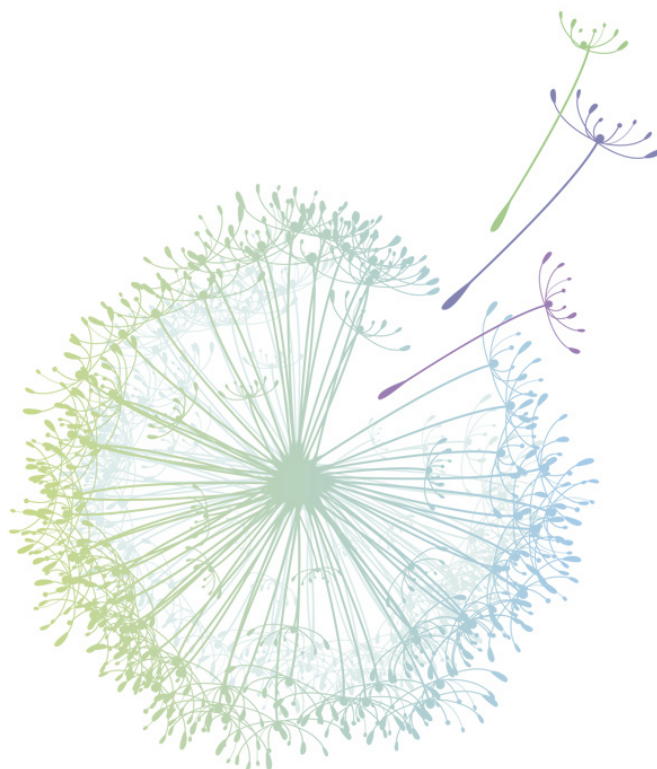
- **General:** Books to a value of 150 Euros
- **IYSTD:** Books to a value of 150 Euros
- **Facebook:** Digital Book

Seventh. Presentation of Prizes.

The judging panel will be made up of People Selected by the centre. The Judges decision will be final. The submission of one or more photographs will signal acceptance of the rules. The finalists and the winners of the competition will be advised by telephone or email once the Judges have made their decision.

The prizes will be awarded on Thursday 6th March in the closing ceremony of the 7th SCIENCE WEEK.
